
# WHAT IS EVANGELIUM21?

# KEVIN DEYOUNG

Kevin DeYoung (MDiv, Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary) is senior pastor at University Reformed Church in East Lansing, Michigan. He blogs at the Gospel Coalition and has authored or coauthored numerous well-known books. He and his wife Trisha have six children.

# WILLIAM TAYLOR

William Taylor is the Rector at St. Helen 's, Bishopsgate, a church located in the heart of the financial district of London. He is part of a network in Great Britain that offers bible-centered training for young Christians. He is married to Janet and they have three children.

# STEPHEN NICHOLS

Stephen Nichols (PhD, Westminster Theological Seminary) is president of Reformation Bible College and chief academic officer of Ligonier Ministries. Previously, he served as research professor of Christianity and culture at Lancaster Bible College. He is an editor (with Justin Taylor) of the Theologians on the Christian Life series and is the author of several books. He and his wife Heidi have three children.
